

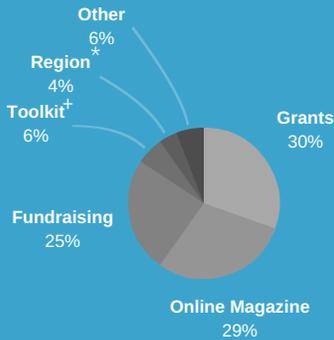
Priority Plan Poll - Results

Internal Administrative

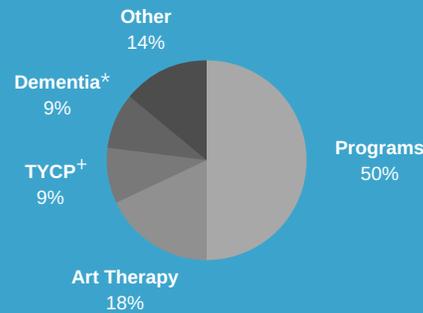


Seeking Grants (68 votes) and increasing fundraising (56 votes) made up the bulk of what the membership would like to see us pursue.

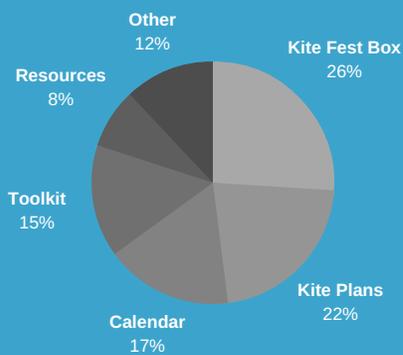
Outreach

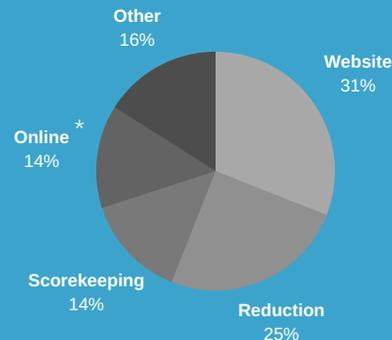


Kite Festival in a box (66 votes) and social media toolkits (39 votes) were important and similar options.

Over 20% of members also voiced that they would like some version of a kite plan database.

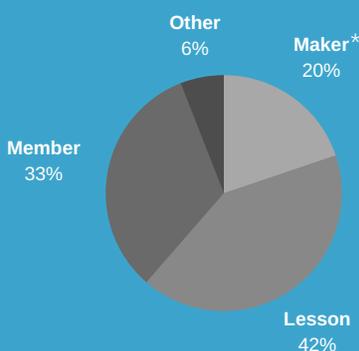
Sport Kite
